

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANORVILLE, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA,

Regulating and restricting outdoor fires within the Borough of Manorville, and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MANORVILLE, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG, AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME:

Section 1. No person or persons shall set or maintain any fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public grounds in the Borough of Manorville, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves or other material or substance of any kind.

Section 2. Out-of-door fires shall be permitted upon private property in the Borough of Manorville between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 6:30 P.M. (EST) on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays between November 1 and April 30 and between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 8:30 P.M. (DST) on Tuesday, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, between May 1 and October 31, provided, however that every such out-of-door fire shall be properly controlled and supervised so as not to emit excessive and offensive smoke and fumes by reason of smoldering beyond a reasonable time following the setting of said fire. Within a reasonable time following the permissible burning periods all smoldering materials emitting smoke or other offensive odors shall be smothered or quenched with water.

Section 3. A permit may be obtained from the Mayor or from the Chief of Police with permission of the Mayor to permit burning otherwise prohibited by this ordinance, except that a separate permit shall be required for each burning.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon summary conviction

thereof be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$50.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.

Section 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.
